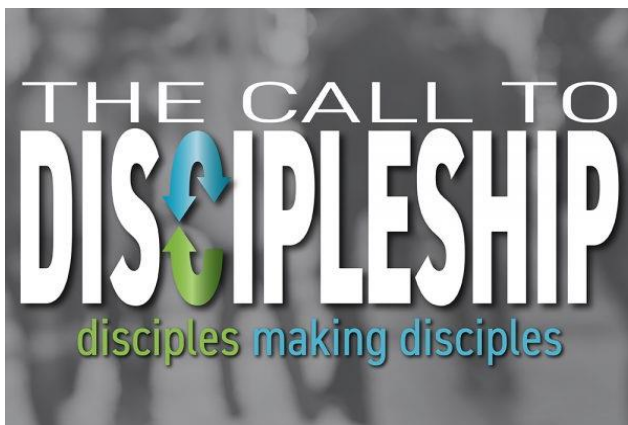
WELCOME TO WORSHIP AT ST PETER'S BRIBIE ISLAND

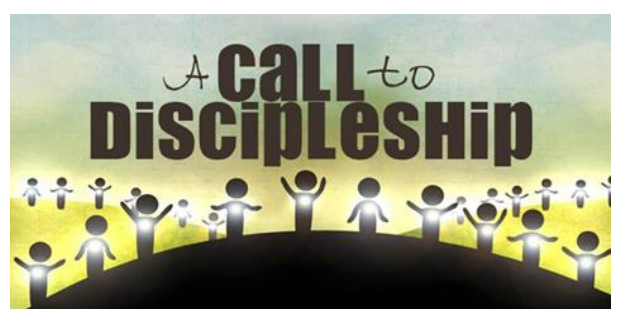
