### **THE SEASON OF LENT**

Lent is the period of 40 days (not including Sundays) which comes before Easter. Lent is a season of reflection and preparation before the celebrations of Easter.

### **WHAT CHANGES DURING LENT**

Liturgical Colour - Purple is used for two reasons: firstly because it is associated with mourning and so anticipates the pain and suffering of the crucifixion, and secondly because purple is the colour associated with royalty, and celebrates Christ's resurrection and sovereignty.

Flowers - There are no flowers in the church during Lent, reflecting the focus on repentance over celebration.

Praise - As we focus on repentance over celebration the responses during the service are said rather than sung, the Gloria is also omitted.

Morning Tea - Morning tea after the Sunday services is simplified to reflect our call to live simply. A donation bowl is placed on the table for those who would like to give to the work of missions.
