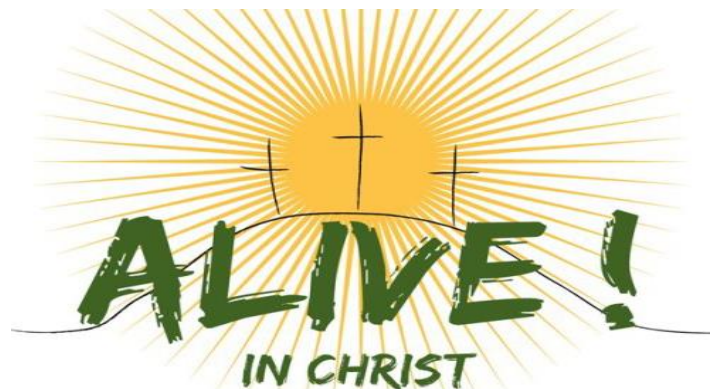

HOLY COMMUNION

Worshippers who have a cold/virus or have had one in the past week are requested to receive Holy Communion in one kind; that is to receive the bread and not the wine. To reduce the spread of illness, please abstain from drinking or intinction from the common chalice. Intinction by communicants is not recommended. Intinction from the chalice increases the risk of spreading illness because the ends of fingers can come into contact with the wine. If you have some other reason for intinction please use the intinction cup with the priest.
