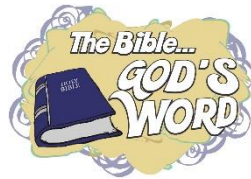

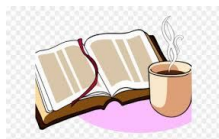

HOLY COMMUNION

Worshippers who have a cold/virus or have had one in the past week are requested to receive Holy Communion in one kind; that is to receive the bread and not the wine. To reduce the spread of illness, please abstain from drinking or intinction from the common chalice. Intinction by communicants is not recommended. Intinction from the chalice increases the risk of spreading illness because the ends of fingers can come into contact with the wine. If you have some other reason for intinction, please use the intinction cup with the priest.

FLASHLIGHT PENS ARE BACK - These pens which combine the convenience of a pocket flashlight in a silver barrel with blue ink and St. Peter's Logo are now available from Lynn Macbeth or the Parish Office. Cost remains at \$5.00.

TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE - Transportation assistance is being offered for people who need a ride to get to church on a Sunday morning. Interested persons should contact Frankie Park on 3408 8648 by Friday afternoon each week, so a driver can be allotted. If you can help out as a driver, please contact Frankie. Drivers will not be required to provide weekly transport.

PANTRY HELP - We are collecting pantry items each week which we pass on to Bribie Island and District Neighbourhood Centre for distribution to those in need in our community. The following items are helpful - pasta, spaghetti sauce, other pasta sauces, rice, cooking oil, 2 minute noodles, cuppa soup, longlife milk, tea bags, coffee, sugar, jams, peanut butter, vegemite, cereals, fruit juices, muesli bars and tinned items like tuna, salmon, sardines, soups, meals, vegetables, spaghetti and baked beans. Items can be placed in the marked box in the narthex.

CONTAINERS FOR CHANGE - The Parish is collecting aluminium, glass, plastic, steel and liquid paperboard beverage containers between 150ml and 3L as a fundraising activity. Eligible containers will be marked with a 10 cent refund logo. As a general rule if you can buy it at a cafe or bar, and would drink out of the container, it is an eligible container. For more information please read through the following guide. A number of drink containers are not eligible for a refund under the scheme. These include plain milk containers, glass containers which have contained wine or pure spirits, large containers (1L or more) which have contained flavoured milk, pure juice, cask wine or cask water, cordial or vegetable juice containers, sachets above 250ml which have contained wine, registered health tonics. If you would like to support this program, please bring in your eligible containers and place them in the red bin located in the church hallway. If you would like someone to collect your containers, please speak to Greg Rollason.
