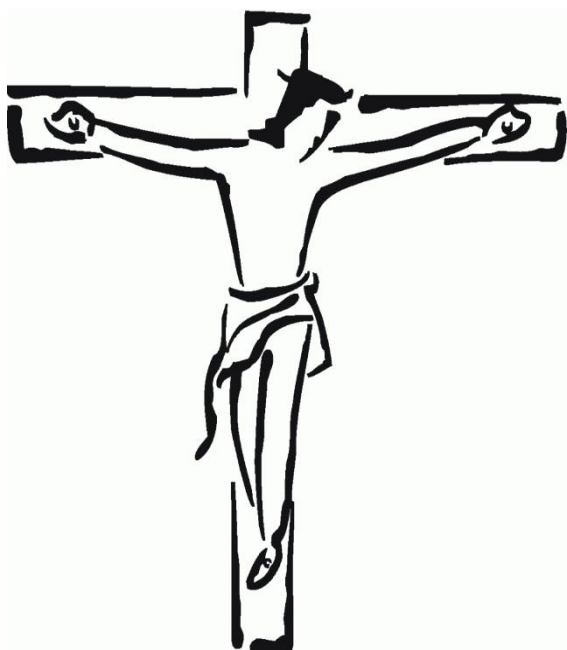
WELCOME TO WORSHIP AT ST PETER'S BRIBIE ISLAND

ANNUAL CHRISM EUCHARIST

You are invited to take part in this annual liturgy where the Archbishop will consecrate the "oil of Chrism" (used in baptism, dedication and consecrations), the "oil of Catechumens" (used to anoint those preparing for Baptism) and the "oil of the sick". The liturgy also offers the opportunity for clergy to reaffirm their ordination vows and for the laity to recommit themselves to ministry. Service will be held at St John's Cathedral on Tuesday 16 April at 7pm.
