## **HOLY COMMUNION**

Worshippers who have recently had a cold or virus are requested to receive Holy Communion in one kind; that is to receive the bread and not the wine. To reduce the spread of illness, please abstain from drinking or intincting from the chalice.

Intinction by communicants is not recommended. When people intinct there is a risk that the ends of fingers could come into contact with the wine.

All baptised and communicant members of other Christian Churches professing the Apostolic (or historic Christian) faith are invited to receive Holy Communion. If you require a gluten-free wafer at communion please simply ask the priest when at the altar rail. If you wish to receive a blessing rather than communion, please ask the priest at the altar rail
