HOW TO FAST? ... Fast from hurting words and say kind words. Fast from sadness and be filled with gratitude. Fast from anger and be filled with patience. Fast from pessimism and be filled with hope. Fast from worries and have trust in God. Fast from complaints and contemplate simplicity. Fast from bitterness and fill your hearts with joy. Fast from selfishness and be compassionate to others. Fast from grudges and be reconciled. Fast from words and be silent so you can listen.

2019 LENT APPEAL - Funds donated to the 2019 appeal will support three partner projects. Gender & Governance Initiative in Zambia strives to end child marriage and to end the conditions of poverty and ignorance, and the low status of women that sustain it. ZACOP is educating people about the rights of women and children, helping them to claim these rights, and providing services to support victims of gender-based violence (GBV). St John's Anglican Seminary in Zambia, ABM supports training for ordinands and clergy from all five Anglican dioceses across Zambia. The training prepares them to minister in fast-growing urban and rural congregations of the Church. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Mission Fund make small grants available to projects which express the marks of mission and benefits relevant programs.
