Dear Parishioners

At the Parish Council meeting on 8 January, the financial statement for 2019 and the proposed annual budget for 2020 was presented by the Treasurer. The Profit and Loss Statement for January to December for the past year has a net loss of \$12,940, after income of \$125,393 and expenses of \$138,334.

The Fundraising Committee which was charged with the responsibility of raising funds to cover the Parish Mission Giving as outlined in the 2019 budget raised \$9,041.24 – a gallant effort by all who supported their endeavours and a figure slightly above the budgeted amount.

Comparing the previous year's financial statements for 2018 – 2019 the Offerings have decreased drastically from \$120,573 to \$106,762. This is a dramatic drop and concern for the Parish. If this trend is to continue again this year the Parish Council's concern is that funds set aside for recurring expenses would need to be accessed.

As Wardens charged with overseeing a balanced budget, we are urging Parishioners to consider increasing their financial commitment to our Parish to ensure all ministries and expenses can be covered for 2020.

Hopefully we will all prayerfully give this request thought, and, with extra funds our Parish will continue to do God's mission by helping others and maintaining our current programs.

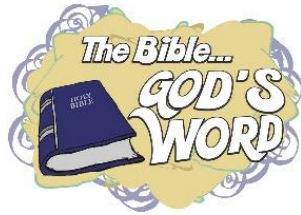

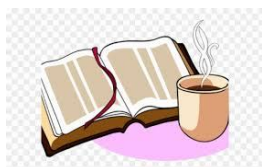

HOLY COMMUNION

Worshippers who have a cold/virus or have had one in the past week are requested to receive Holy Communion in one kind; that is to receive the bread and not the wine. To reduce the spread of illness, please abstain from drinking or intinction from the common chalice. Intinction by communicants is not recommended. Intinction from the chalice increases the risk of spreading illness because the ends of fingers can come into contact with the wine. If you have some other reason for intinction, please use the intinction cup with the priest.
