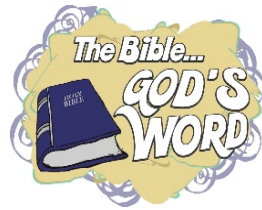

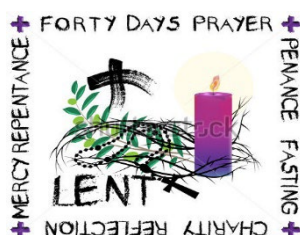

NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) AND HOW WE GATHER FOR WORSHIP

Stay away if you are feeling unwell - Health Department has advised the church to reduce the risk of spreading contagions if people are feeling ill, even mildly so, they should not attend worship or church events.

Refrain from Physical Contact with others - please refrain from making physical contacts with others at worship and all church activities, this includes handshakes, hugs and kisses.

Meeting of all Parish Groups - all nonessential gatherings in the Parish will be placed on hold until further notice. Sunday morning and Wednesday morning Eucharists will continue until otherwise advised.

Morning Tea after Church - activities where food is shared will be placed on hold until further notice, this includes morning tea after church.

Holy Communion - The Archbishop has directed that communion is to be in one kind only (the bread). To reduce shared contact points communion is to be received standing and not kneeling at the altar rails.

Offering Plate - the offertory plate will not be passed around, but offerings must be placed in the box prior to worship.

Wash your hands - please ensure you are following proper hand washing and hand sanitising techniques and sanitising your hands before receiving communion.

LENTEN SERVICE - Sunday evening Lenten Services have now been cancelled.
