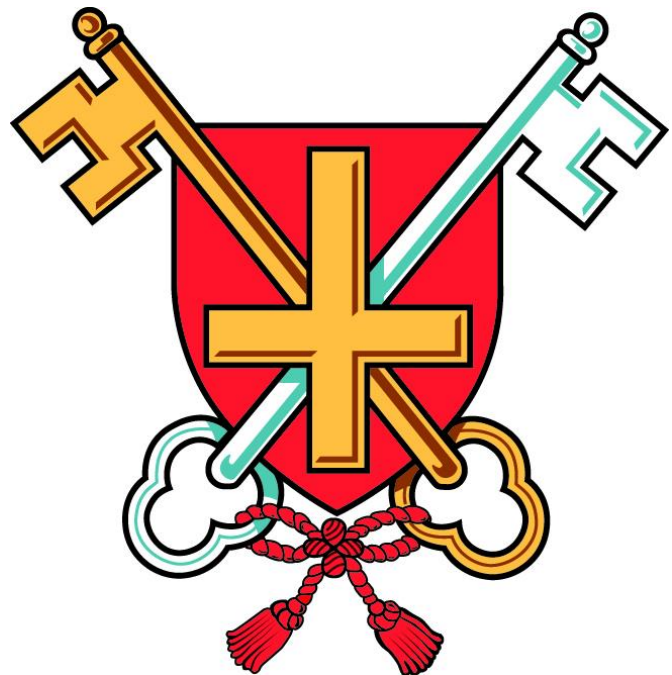

Pictured above is the cross of St Peter. The upside-down cross is symbolic of Peter's crucifixion which was upside down. Peter felt he was not worthy to die in the same manner as Jesus, so he requested to be crucified upside down.

The crossed keys, one gold, one silver, represent the power of losing and binding. The gold key alludes to the power in the kingdom of the heavens and the silver key indicates the spiritual authority on earth. The cord with the bows that unites the grips alludes to the bond between the two powers.

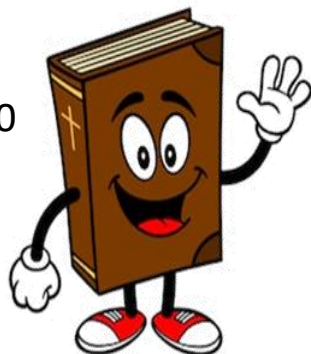
