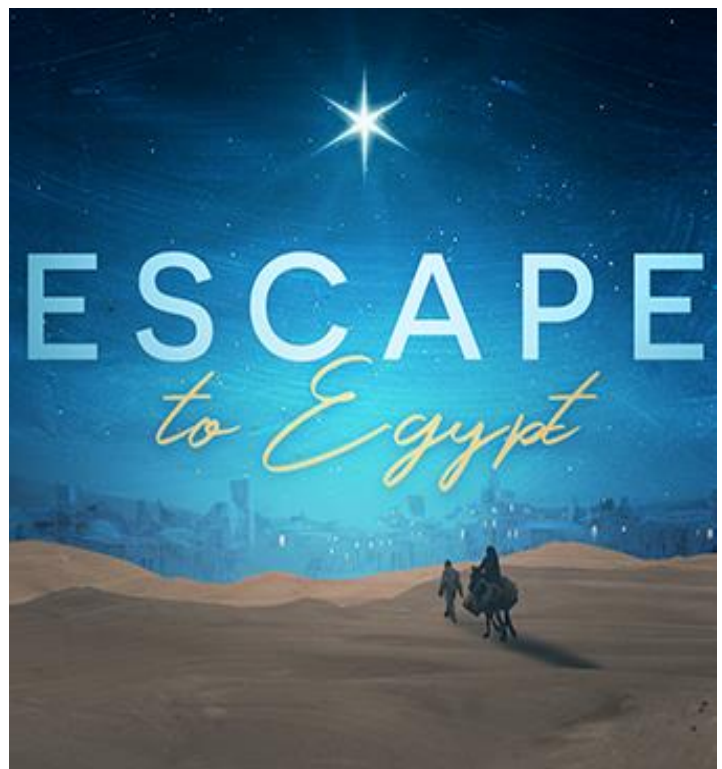

### **HOLY COMMUNION**

Worshippers who have a cold/virus or have had one in the past week are requested to receive Holy Communion in one kind; that is to receive the bread and not the wine. To reduce the spread of illness, please abstain from drinking or intinction from the common chalice. Intinction by communicants is not recommended. Intinction from the chalice increases the risk of spreading illness because the ends of fingers can come into contact with the wine. If you have some other reason for intinction, please use the intinction cup with the priest.

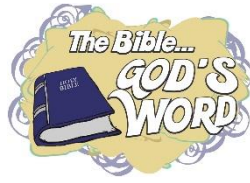

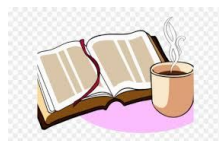

Nominations are called for the positions of Churchwarden, Parish Nominator and Parish Councillor and these nominations need to be submitted to Fr Steven by Sunday 16 February. Anyone over the age of 70 who wishes to nominate for the position of Churchwarden or Parish Nominator should submit their nomination to Fr Steven prior to the next Parish Council meeting on Wednesday 8 January for endorsement by Parish Council.

The song 12 Days of Christmas was written as a way to teach the Christian faith in secret code. On the first day of Christmas my true love gave to me, a partridge in a pear tree, symbolising God (true love) and Jesus Christ (the partridge). Second day: two turtle doves were the Old and New Testaments. Third day: Three French hens represented the three gifts of faith, hope and love. Fourth day: Calling birds were the four gospels. Fifth day: Five golden rings were the Books of Moses. Sixth day: Geese a-laying stands for the six days of creation. Seventh day: Swans a-swimming were the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit. Eighth day: Maids a-milking were the eight beatitudes. Ninth day: Ladies dancing were the nine fruits of the Holy Spirit such as charity, peace and kindness. Tenth day: Lords a-leaping represent the 10 Commandments. Eleventh day: Pipers piping were the 11 apostles. Twelfth day: Twelve drummers drumming represented the points of the Apostles Creed.
